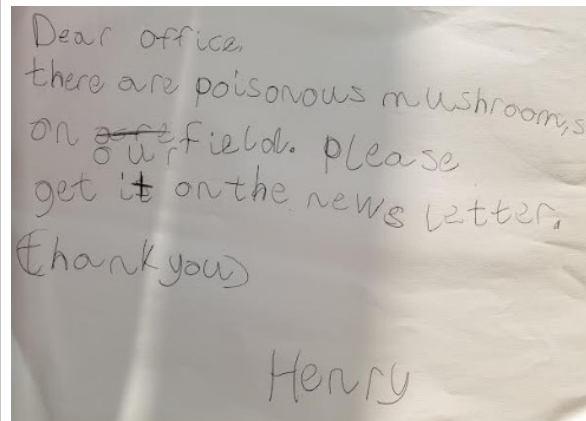

## Expansion News

Building works commence again on Monday 22nd October. The KS1 playground will be the compound of the new building works and will therefore not be accessible for the remainder of the year. From Monday onwards, please use the following doors for drop-offs in the morning:

**Nursery and Reception Classes**—use current doors

**Y1 Classes** - please enter through the main school door where a member of staff will be ready to greet you from from 8.40—8.50am

**Y2 - Y6 Classes** - please enter through the KS2 door by Tots' new play area. Mrs Dalton and Mrs Lyon will be out in the morning to guide you if you are unsure where to go.

For collection at the end of the day:

**Nursery and Reception Classes** - use current doors

**Y1 Classes** - collection through the main school door

**Y2 , Y3 and Y4 Classes** - collection through the doors leading to the courtyard outside Mrs Lyon's Office - signs for each class will be up.

**Y5 and Y6 Classes** - will be leaving through the KS2 door leading out to Tots' new play area.

Please remember that after half term the school Office will be temporarily relocated as part of the expansion. So please bear with us on the first week back as we are unable to move into our new office until Monday 5th November.



**Parking - please do not park inconsiderately outside of school. Parking on pavements makes it incredibly dangerous for our children.**
