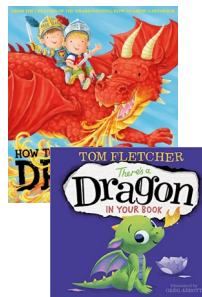
Our language focus next week will be on asking and answering 'what' and 'where' questions. Try to ask these if you are reading a story or out for a walk.
